



Poster Art Contest Rules

Grades 3 through 6

Prize awarded to each grade-level winner

1. The Poster Art must:

- a. Depict the eligible participant's interpretation of the theme, "Every Human Life is Beautiful". This can include the born or unborn.
- b. Be an original work of art in any of the following **2D** media/formats:

Colored Drawing: Colored pencil, pastels, crayon, conte, chalks, lead pencil, charcoal, pen and ink, oil pastel, watercolor, ink washes, acrylics, tempera, designer colors, gouache, inks and dyes.

Mixed Medium: The use of any mixture of two or more mediums, for example, watercolor with pencil or pen and ink with watercolor.

- c. Be no larger than a 22"x 28" poster
 - d. Be created in 2023
 - e. Contain no copyrighted material
 - f. Contain no threatening, offensive, or abusive words or art
 - g. Show a title for the art. Use limited wording on the art except for the title. Student's name cannot be seen on the artwork.
2. Register and submit artwork by November 1, 2023, at lifefirst.org/poster-art-contest/.
3. One entry allowed per student per contest year.
5. Each poster will be evaluated on originality, adherence to the theme and presentation of pro-life message, artistic ability, and overall effect. All decisions by the judges are final.

Awards are as follows:

3rd grade winner - \$50

4th grade winner - \$50

5th grade winner - \$100

6th grade winner - \$100

6. Winners will be notified via email after the contest deadline. Digital images of the winning posters may be reproduced and displayed at the LifeFirst Dinner for Life. Digital image and reproduction rights belong to LifeFirst.
7. Student must be currently enrolled in 3rd - 6th grades and reside in Texas.
