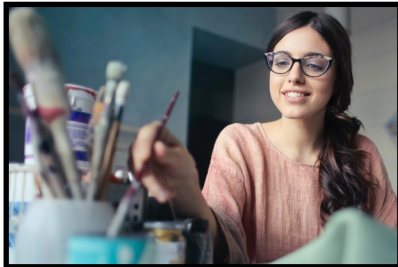
Poster Art Contest
